Please check as many volunteer opportunities as you are interested in:

	ACS Freshman Mock Interviews: Twice a year, train, practice with, and interview freshman students in the ACS classes. Each session is just one class period, so working parents can do this with minimal time away from work. January & May 2019.
	Back to School BBQ: Help prepare and serve food for the new student BBQ.
	Book Collection: Help the staff for 2-3 hours at the end of the school year collecting textbooks.
	Concessions: Help sell concessions during some of the home sporting events to help raise funds for your students' class.
	Counseling Dept. Support (Laker Lighthouse): A few helpers needed for regular monthly upkeep/decorating of counseling dept. bulletin board and a few others needed for easy monthly data entry of student-related career experiences. Occasional other jobs.
