Another suggestion graduating class work with principal to determine gift for school from the graduating class. Goal is to find most fair and equitable way to distribute or adjust the access funds. More discussion at May meeting once we have better idea of ticket sales and expenses for grad night 2018. One additional point to consider is that overall volunteerism is down and cutting grad budget may have impact on years to come.
6. **ACS Interviews Update:**
 - a. May 14-May 17 are ACS Interviews that are conducted through the freshman class communications class. Looking for 75 volunteers to assist on all 4 days with preparing students for interviews and then actually conducting those interviews. Sign up genius will be used to gather volunteers. This is a very important activity and seeking full volunteer support from LOHS families.
